- C. Israel "agreed" with God. (Exodus 4.31; 19.1-8; Deuteronomy 1.19-25)
- D. And they could have had Canaan within 18 months, but... (Numbers 13.25-14.3)
- E. Israel "disagreed" with God...
  - 1. They said, "We can't take the promised land."
  - 2. But God said... (Deuteronomy 1.26; Numbers 14.11, 33)
